EXO BEST Responsible Initiative 2019 for GREEN RIVER

The Green River Project was born in 2017 when, on a common ground, people from EXO Travel realized that the rivers were filled with wastes and plastic. Not only this was damaging the landscape, it was also harmful for people living nearby, because of the chemicals of burnt waste and plastic that they had to face on daily basis.



The Green River Story

We started our project in Phnom Penh within the partnership of Prek Leap National College of Agriculture (PNCA) and its 235 students. After receiving the training from EXO Travel, PNCA students went to talk to the neighbors living near by the university and knock on every doors to explain them the consequences of throwing garbage and plastic in the river.

In 2018 we have extended the project to Siem Reap, in collaboration with our long term partners, Sala Bai School and Artisans of Angkor to train their staff and students to adopt good waste management practices and raising awareness about the plastic effect on health. Through 4 workshops lead by our S. Team member in Khmer language, we have been able to reach more than 140 people.

In 2019, EXO S.Team was pushing further its action!

Thanks to our fruitful collaboration, we have decided to renew 2 more sessions at Artisans Of Angkor to train more than 50 supervisors at the silk village and brainstorm on plastic free/less in their production process.

We have invited GAEA (waste collection company based in Siem Reap) to be part of the second Green River Project at Sala Bai School and trained together 150+ students. The day after, the trainees became the trainers. Sala Bai students shared their knowledge to 70 kids around 10 years old from the Wat Svay primary School before going all together along the Siem Reap River to collect 250 kgs of trashes in 1 hour only!

We were extremely happy with the results as more than 180 persons participated, even the chief district. All participants received the EXO Foundation comic book "Don't waste your waste" and more than 120 refillable bottles were given to the primary students.

We also started a collaboration with GIZ and Plastic Free Cambodia to reach 50 Khnar Po villagers, a community living by the river, EXO Foundation has sponsored a training helping them to prevent the pollution of their natural surroundings.


